Any Kansas 4-H member between the ages of 14 and 18 before January 1, 2025 may apply as a Council Rep and those 15-18 before January 1, 2025 may apply for National Conference.

This year's KYLF delegation will elect representatives from the four extension program areas (NE, NW, SE, SW) for one year term on council. Up to 6 National Conference Delegates will be selected through an interview process at KYLF and they serve a two year term on council.

Application information for State 4-H Youth Leadership Council and National Conference will be available in late August. The deadline will be October 1, 2024.
